The Algonac Art Fair Scholarship Questions & Answers

1. Who may apply?

Any high school senior residing in the Algonac Community School District, who is graduating from High School and will be attending a two-year or more college or art school with the intention of pursuing a career in an art related field.

2. What is the scholarship based on?

The scholarship committee takes into account your grade point average and the courses you took, your past experience in art, your plans for the future, original samples of your work, your application, and your recommendation letters

3. What must I submit with my application?

- a) A copy of your acceptance from the school you are planning to attend.
- b) A copy of your high school transcript.
- c) Two original examples of your artwork framed for hanging and protected. (Artwork will be returned)
- d) Two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, guidance counselor or principal.

4. How much is the scholarship?

Recipients attending a two-year or more program/school may be awarded a scholarship of \$500.

5. Is the scholarship awarded each year?

No, the scholarship is awarded based on the discretion of the committee.

6. When will I know if I am awarded a scholarship?

Scholarships are awarded at the annual senior awards assembly.

7. How are the funds paid out?

The funds will be paid directly to the student upon completion of his/her first college semester. A copy of the transcript from their first semester must be emailed to the committee. This information will be included in the award packet.
