# Scholarship Application Requirements / Fulfillment:

- Applicants must be a 2021 Algonac High School graduating senior.
- Must meet scholarship criteria, submit essay, and demonstrate superior financial need.
- No minimum GPA required.
- The scholarship is awarded via check made out to student following successful completion of first semester of college (Minimum 12 credits/2.8 GPA/With passing grade in all classes), including proof of enrollment as full-time student for the following semester.

# All applicants to include a cover sheet with the following support information:

- First/Last name, email address, home mailing address, and contact number(s).
- Name of the school the student plans to attend to pursue advanced education.
- The degree/field of interest the student plans to pursue.

# Scholarship Essay:

Applicants are to answer the following questions, in essay format, which allows applicants freedom to fully express themselves and share context regarding their unique situations:

- 1. Tell us about yourself!
  - a. Share attributes that best describe you.
  - b. What are your interests? What is important to you? What defines you?
- 2. What is your vision for your future after high school?
- 3. How will your education help you achieve your career goals?
  - a. What will be your major/minor?
  - b. How long do you anticipate it will take you to complete your education?
  - c. Do you plan gain experience within your chosen field within on-campus activities and/or internships?
  - d. What do you feel will be the biggest challenges to complete your education?
  - e. Approx 50% of college freshman will not graduate: Why do you believe you will overcome any challenges and obstacles to complete your education?
- 4. Explain your financial need and any circumstances that contribute to your financial need:
  - a. Share any support information you would like in how you plan to pay for college, including any cost cutting strategies and/or sacrifices you plan to make, i.e. attending community college to take your GenEd classes, and/or summer courses at a community college, living off campus, take a financial literacy class, how you will earn money during winter/spring/summer breaks, etc.

# **Optional:**

- One Letter of Recommendation.
- Completed Budget Worksheet (see below/attached).
- Resume (see below/attached).

### Selection Process:

- 1. All applicants to be reviewed by each scholarship committee member, in which finalists will be identified.
- 2. Finalists to be interviewed in-person at Algonac High School by members of the scholarship committee in late April/early May, 2021.

# Did You Know:

- Less than one-third of Americans hold at least a Bachelor's degree.
- College graduates out-earn people without college degrees by over 60%.
- Four-Year-Myth: 19% of college students complete a bachelor's degree in four years and 36% of college students complete their degree on time.
- Business is still the most common college major (Approx 20%).
- 1,750,000 college graduates per year.
- 1,125,000 students drop out of college per year.
- 1,1250,000 college students transfer per year.
- 60% of bachelor's degree recipients change colleges, with almost half of them losing credits.
- The average student loan debt upon graduation is over \$30,000.
- 23% of full-time college students work 20 hours or more a week.
- The average family income for 50% of under-graduates is less than \$40,000.
- Average number of missed classes per college student each year is 26.
- Average number of drooped classes per college student each year is two.
- Average number of parking tickets per college student each year is two!
